



**Village at Worthington Civic Association Meeting  
Thursday, January 21, 2021**

**Monthly Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was held via Zoom.

Nick Sisco called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. A motion was made to approve the previous meeting minutes. The motion was seconded and approved.

Sue shared the dues collection report. She shared that 3 districts were at 100%. The VWCA has collected 193 of 222 homes (87%).

Sue also presented the financials. There has no major financial activity since the last meeting, only some dues collected and AEP bills. Everything is up to date. Balances are below:

Sue then mentioned that she received a quote for BioGreen applications for the year, which was \$244 (a \$27 savings). A motion was made, seconded and approved for the BioGreen applications.

Communication Committee shared that the website and Facebook are up to date and functioning as expected. The entrance signs will be updated in a few weeks.

Eric Harned attended FNCCC and shared via email that there was only one item. The FNCCC approved a zoning variance for order pickup poles and lights at Target,

Mary of the Social Committee shared some ideas about the Easter Egg Hunt. It was proposed that the VWCA organize Easter Egg Hunt To-Go, whereby residents register for a bag of eggs with a prize to be delivered by the Easter Bunny to their house. All liked the idea and planning is underway. The event will take place on March 27<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of March 28<sup>th</sup>. A motion was made, seconded and approved for \$250 for funding the event.

Dora brought up the topic of the Mulch sale and whether we could do it. We believe we can make it work this year but will wait and have more discussion in later meetings.

Sue discussed various aspects of the directory. New bags will be needed for the folders. Trustees and officers will work to put the physical copies together and distribute.
