



**Village at Worthington Civic Association Meeting
Thursday, March 25, 2021**

Monthly Meeting Minutes

The meeting was held via Zoom.

Nick Sisco called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. A motion was made to approve the previous meeting minutes. The motion was seconded and approved.

Rich presented the financials. Since the last meeting, VWCA reflects \$85.14 in expenses with the only income being a penny of interest. This brings account totals to:

Sue shared the collection report. The VWCA has collected 194 homes (87.4%).

Sue shared updates for the Welcome Committee regarding sold homes and pending sales.

Communication Committee shared that the website, Facebook and entrance signs are up to date.

There was no FNCCC meeting in March.

The Group discussed the Easter Egg Hunt scheduled for Saturday March 27th at the park.

The Group discussed having the annual garage sale in June. We agreed this could occur. Residents can participate if they feel comfortable. The event will be held on a Saturday from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Precycle day for Worthington will be on April 24th. The event was discussed. Residents are welcome to participate, however this event is not organized by the VWCA.

Fred discussed spring cleanup at the entrances as well as purchase of flowers. A motion was made, seconded and approved for \$400 expenditures for the front entrance. Spring cleanup and regular mowing will be performed by J&G Lawncare at a similar rate as prior years.

Rich detailed the research he had done regarding the snow removal inquiries over the winter. The City of Columbus does not permit HOAs to plow City of Columbus roads. This creates liability issues for the VWCA. Additionally, private contractor would need EPA signoff on their equipment. All agreed that based on his research it is not feasible for the VWCA to be responsible for snow removal. It was recommended this be communicated on posted on the website during an off-winter season so that we can refer to this in the future when the issue arises.

Becky shared that her neighbor, Angie Gerding, at 421 Greencamp was willing to take on co-trustee duties.

The next meeting will be held Wednesday, April 28, 2021 via Zoom.

Nick Sisco asked for a motion for adjournment. It was so adjourned at 7:57 PM.
